FABRIC ELASTIC HAIRBANDS



YOU WILL NEED

- 1. Fabric scraps
- 2. ³/₄ inch elastic
- 3. Basic sewing supplies

- Cut fabric and elastic:
 Fabric piece 1: 16 inches by 6 ¼ inches
 Fabric piece 2: 10 ½ inches by 2 ¾ inches
 Elastic: 6 inches
- Hem the edges of the long piece of fabric with a very narrow hem. We used a narrow hem foot on the chiffon, but ironed the cotton ¹/₈ inch, pressed and folded another ¹/₈ inch.
- Fold the smaller piece of fabric in half, right sides together and sew along the edge using a scant ³/₈ inch seam allowance. (Trim excess seam allowance.) Turn right side out.
- 4. Thread elastic through the tube, pin at each end.
- 5. Baste elastic at each end.
- Sew a narrow hem along the long edges of the larger piece of fabric.







- Position the elasticated piece on top of the larger piece of fabric with rough edges together.
- 8. Pleat the remaining fabric leaving enough to fold over the elastic.
- Sew along the short ends leaving a 3/8ths inch seam allowance.
